## **Section 5: Qualitative Assessment**

### **1. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local homeless goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlists, etc.)**

HEAP funds have allowed the City of Los Angeles to make progress toward the its goal to permanently house unsheltered residents by expanding access to interim housing, services, and service referrals. More specifically, expenditures through September 30, 2019 have allowed for the creation of an additional 387 beds in the City's A Bridge Home (ABH) program, which provides low-barrier interim housing beds to unhoused residents, and an additional 356,712 individual uses of the Mobile Pit Stop program, which provides hygiene facilities throughout the City as well as employment opportunities to ex-offenders, some of whom are experiencing homelessness or are at-risk of homelessness.

In support of the ABH program, the City has partnered with the County of Los Angeles, which has committed to support a large portion of the services costs for up to 600 new ABH beds for three years. The City supplements the County's \$50/bed/night contribution to these beds with an additional \$10/bed/night from the City's HEAP grant.

### **2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)**

HEAP funds have allowed the City of Los Angeles to make progress toward the its goal to get unhoused youth off the streets and into permanent housing by expanding access to interim housing, services, and service referrals. Through September 30, 2019, HEAP funds from the Youth Set-Aside have been spent on capital to expand the number of low-barrier interim housing beds available to the City's unhoused youth population. A total of 15 new TAY family units have been added with the capacity to serve up to 42 total family members.



**3. Describe the alignment between HEAP-funded activities and "Housing First" principles (as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code section 8255).**

All City-operated or City-funded programs strictly follow "Housing First" principles, consistent with the definition in Welfare and Institutions Code section 8255. The majority of funds expended through September 30, 2019, have supported the A Bridge Home (ABH) program, which provides low-barrier access to interim housing beds for persons experiencing homelessness. Services are informed by a harm-reduction philosophy. Participation in services or program compliance is not a condition of participation in any City-funded programs.

**4. Please provide any additional feedback on the impact of HEAP funds that you would like to share with the Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council. (Optional)**

The flexible, emergency nature of the HEAP funds was essential to allow the City to respond to the most acute problems facing our unsheltered residents experiencing homelessness. The City was able to quickly allocate HEAP funding to create new interim housing beds, and to provide urgently-needed hygiene services, such as restrooms and showers serving encampments throughout the City. The State's administration of the grant, especially the speed of the application review process and disbursement of funds, allowed the City to have an immediate impact with the funds on existing street homelessness.
