Section 5: Qualitative Assessment

1. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local homeless goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlists, etc.)

Throughout the years, it has been difficult for Imperial County to expand its homeless assistance programs and capacity to coordinate existing services due to limited funding opportunities. HEAP funds are allowing Imperial County's CoC to increase its efforts on strategies to address homelessness in our community through capacity building, expansion of homeless services, increase of homeless prevention services and an increase of permanent supportive housing beds dedicated to homeless or at risk homeless individuals in our community.

The Imperial Valley Continuum of Care (IVCCC) Executive Board established the following funding principles that will be supported through local HEAP funded projects and help make progress toward local homeless goals:

a) Invest in programs that support Imperial County's service priorities: permanent housing, rapid re-housing, emergency shelters, transitional housing and supportive services to end homelessness; b) Invest in programs that support Imperial County's homeless population priorities and align with HUD-recommended subpopulations such as veterans, youth, families and chronically homeless individuals; c) Invest in programs that work towards eradicating homelessness in the region by addressing the underlying causes and lessening the negative impact on individuals, families, and community; d) Invest in programs that address significant service gaps among the chronically homeless and establish accountable, long-term, and sustainable results; e) Invest in programs that support the housing first policy and emphasize on a comprehensive coordinated service delivery approach to wraparound services to ensure successful housing and self-sufficiency outcomes.

2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)

Between 2015-2019, there has been a 30% increase of homeless unaccompanied youth between the ages of 18-24 years and whom also account for 5% of our overall homeless population in Imperial County. The CoC has dedicated a total of 5% of HEAP funds to a youth homeless program out of Imperial Valley College (IVC), which is a local community college. IVC has identified close to 200 youth ages 18-24 that have experience homelessness in the last 12 months at their college. Project DREAM's goals align with those of the CoC which is to address, mitigate and prevent youth homelessness. HEAP funds will allow us to increase youth services capacity and provide additional services to homeless youth through Project Dream. This program will provide support services to homeless youth ages 18-24 such as supportive case management, counseling, peer support, independent living skills workshops, job placement, transportation assistance, and emergency assistance/supportive services.

3. Describe the alignment between HEAP-funded activities and "Housing First" principles (as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code section 8255).
The Imperial Valley Continuum of Care Council (IVCCC) established funding principle to guide and prioritize funding allocations such as HEAP to include investing in programs that support the following priorities: permanent housing, rapid re-housing, emergency shelters, transitional housing and supportive services to end homelessness. As a result the IVCCC, allocated 71% of HEAP funding to permanent supportive housing projects and rental assistance programs to ensure that housing opportunities for individuals were prioritized over support services aligning with the basic principle of Housing First of housing is provided first and then support services. In addition, all HEAP subcontracts include language that require service providers to operate and provide eligible activities in a manner that is consistent with Housing First practices.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

During this reporting period, Imperial County focused its efforts to help set up and implement the HEAP program by 1) Identifying funding priorities that aligned with HEAP funds and local homeless goals; 2) Developed a request for proposal to subcontract HEAP funds to homeless service providers; 3) Reviewed, scored, ranked and identified funding recommendations of proposals received; and 4) Developed contracts with HEAP funded subcontractors and provided technical assistance to ensure proposals and HEAP funds are carried out as required prior to implementation. It took the last year for Imperial County to set up the infrastructure to be able to manage HEAP funds and any additional state and federal funding that is made available. In the last year, the CoC transitioned from a local non-profit agency to the county, went through several personnel changes, and changes in the CoC board resulting in a delay of activity implementation related to HEAP funding. It is expected that activities will be carried out and most of the funding will be expended by the next progress report.
