#### 1. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local homeless goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlists, etc.)

Our HEAP funding has injected a vital boost in capacity for our Continuum of Care. Funds have supported the facility work necessary to create entirely new services and sheltering capacity at Building Bridges - a full-service navigation center and emergency shelter in Ukiah. Funds have also provided vital improvements at our local domestic shelter and our homeless shelter and navigation center in Fort Bragg. HEAP funds have also provided vital improvements at our local domestic shelter and our homeless shelter and navigation center in Fort Bragg. HEAP funds have also provided vital improvements at our local domestic shelter and our homeless shelter and navigation center in Fort Bragg. HEAP funds have also expanded the ability of our County Office of Education to provide food and services to hundreds of children experiencing homelessness. Our Continuum of Care is especially enthusiastic aboutallocating HEAP funds to two large, new, Permanent Supportive Housing projects in Fort Bragg and Ukiah. These projects will provide new housing for some of our must vulnerable homeless residents. Overall, HEAP funding has provided catalyst funding to substantially increase capacity to both serve and house homeless individuals and families in Mendocino County.

Please note that this report does not include substantial demographic information related in Section 3: Outcomes. The majority of our HEAP-funded projects were still in the development and/or construction phase by the end of the reporting period. As such, homeless individuals have not yet benefited from these incomplete capital projects. In our next annual report, we anticipate a significantly more detailed summary of individuals served by HEAP funds.

#### 2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)

HEAP funding has provided additional services and capacity for youth homeless as follows:

1) Funding has allowed Mendocino County Office of Education to expand their nutritional and other services to homeless children. The number of children served with weekend meals has increased from roughly 100 children to 223 children served in the last reporting period.

2) Funding will provide facility improvements to the domestic violence shelter in Ukiah. At present, this shelter operates fom an older home with only a single bathroom to serve up to five families at a time. The inadequate bathroom space has limited the number of families fleeing domestic violence that the facility can comfortably provide. With the successful completion of a new bathhouse, built with HEAP funding, this shelter will be able to serve additional families and children for decades to come.

#### 3. Describe the alignment between HEAP-funded activities and "Housing First" principles (as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code section 8255).

All HEAP-funded activities are aligned with Housing First principles. Services are provided with very limited or no barriers to participation, and these principles are embedded within the language of HEAP-funded subcontracts. Once constructed, HEAP-funded new housing will fully comply with Housing First principles in allocating housing for those who qualify for Permanent Supportive Housing. These projects will be obligated to use the CoC's Coordinated Entry system to allocate housing resources according to an impartial vulnerability score.

## Brief Descriptions of Approved HEAP Projects

- 1. **Mendocino County Office of Education,** *Homeless Youth Project for \$135,000.00*: Project funding will be used to provide weekend meals for up to 450 students each week, between April 1, 2019 and June 30, 2021. Project funds will be targeted to those students experiencing or atrisk of homelessness.
- Mendocino Coast Hospitality Center, Capital Improvement Project for \$36,740.00: Project funding will be used to complete two phases of a capital improvement project for the Center. Phase One consists of painting the exterior of 101 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg, CA. Phase Two consists of purchasing and installing a new commercial sanitizing dishwasher for emergency shelter meal service.
- 3. Redwood Community Services, Capital Improvement Project for \$62,1788.86: Project funds will support seven phases of a capital improvement project for the Homeless Services Center, located at 1045 S. State Street in Ukiah. Phase One consists of the purchase of 30 shelter mattresses. Phase Two consists of completing Day Center construction, including bathroom/shower facility, plumbing, electrical, framing, drywall, painting, lighting and fixtures, and some exterior landscaping. Phase Three consists of predevelopment work for the Day Center and Shelter build-out to increase capacity. Phase Four consists of build-out of the Day Center and Shelter to renovate the front portion of building. Phase Five consists of predevelopment of permanent housing to be constructed on the same property, including design and permitting. Phase Six consists of permanent housing site work to develop the parking, sidewalks, and other necessary exterior features. Phase Seven consists of building reconstruction and development including major reconstruction of the roof and exterior walls for the Shelter and Day Center.
- 4. **Project Sanctuary**, *Capital Investment Project for \$132,720.00*: Project funding will be used to complete a bathroom renovation for the Project Sanctuary shelter in Ukiah. Funds will be used for preliminary site work, removal of existing unit, framing construction, plumbing and electrical construction, and the final phases of construction to include doors, drywall, flooring, paint and other associated costs.
- 5. City of Fort Bragg, Capital Improvements Project for \$3,000,000.00: Project funding will be used to contribute to an affordable housing project located in the City of Fort Bragg. Danco Properties is the construction company building "The Plateau," which will include 20 units of permanent supportive housing. The target market for the permanent supportive housing will include: 1) homeless seniors, homeless veterans and homeless families; and 2) seniors, veterans and families that are at risk of becoming homeless.
- 6. Rural Communities Housing Development Corporation, Capital Improvement Project for \$983,414.00: Project funding will be used to contribute to an affordable housing project located in the City of Ukiah. RCHDC will use project funding for a mixed-use 40 to 80 unit affordable housing project called "Orr Creek Commons." The target populations are seriously mentally ill individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, individuals with developmental disabilities, veterans, and very low income families.
- 7. **Mendocino County Health and Human Services Agency**, *Administrative Project for* \$12,305.00: HHSA staffs the MCHSCoC staff who provided support for all aspects of the HEAP funding process, and the fiscal staff who will complete contracting and process funds.
