The HEAP funds allowed for a Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool to be created and provide needed support to individuals and families that have a housing opportunity but need limited financial assistance to lease up. Rapid resolution/diversion programs are now operating. The CoC funded four Permanent Supportive Housing projects which are at various stages of
completion.

The CoC invested in youth homelessness in an area of the County that had not received funding to address youth homelessness. Street engagement is occurring and a PH project for
