1. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local homeless goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlists, etc.)

The HEAP funds allowed for a Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool to be created and provide needed support to individuals and families that have a housing opportunity but need limited financial assistance to lease up. Rapid resolution/diversion programs are now operating. The CoC funded four Permanent Supportive Housing projects which are at various stages of completion.

2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)

The CoC invested in youth homelessness in an area of the County that had not received funding to address youth homelessness. Street engagement is occurring and a PH project for youth near our local community college is nearing completion.

3. Describe the alignment between HEAP-funded activities and "Housing First" principles (as defined in Welfare and Institutions Code section 8255).

HEAP assisted in making Housing First more accepted as the new normal which will have system-wide benefits long term. By expressly defining Housing First in SB 1380, the community and providers have a better understanding of what is needed to serve persons entering Permanent Housing.
