Cal ICH is recruiting individuals with prior lived experience of homelessness to serve as one of eleven seats on the Cal ICH Lived Experience Advisory Board (LEAB).

Cal ICH is a statewide coordinator for policy development and research for state, local, and Tribal partners in their work to prevent and end homelessness in California.

The Opportunity

LEAB members will inform a broad range of decisions of the Council and member departments to ensure systems, programs, and decisions are deeply informed by individuals with lived experience of homelessness.

Members will serve a two-year term beginning in July 2026. Meetings will be held quarterly online via zoom and may include additional meetings as needed.

Cal ICH LEAB members will receive a per diem payment of \$100 for attending and participating in each LEAB quarterly meeting and a \$100 per diem for one day of preparation to review meeting materials in preparation for each quarterly meeting.
