Elevate community-defined youth CES and youth set-aside minimum and overall youth allocation.

Reduce Admin Barriers Is Critical for Funding Restricted NonProfits

Standardize requirements and expectations year over year, rather than having to re-plan every year for new goals/objectives. Single streamlined reporting process for State homeless programs - CWHSP, Bringing Families Home, HHAP, HDAP, HomeSafe, etc. All programs reporting with one EASY report

Less audits so we can expend our resources on housing services. Simplified reporting-effective HMIS integration for reporting across all HMIS software

Sufficient funds to hire qualified staff reducing the rate of turnover. homeless people in the income from resolving homelessness - ie: part time work, employment at jobs that support managed encampments

Increase administrative percentage to better cover costs of infrastructure. better public input during development of programs, more inclusive input processes

Ensure ongoing funding

There could be a qualifications process where agencies are pre-qualified to reduce the burden of multiple applications.

Create Medi-Cal benefit that could be integrated with housing by aligning eligibility

Better measures of things like "first time homelessness" (Currently measured as first entrance into HMIS in 2 years---which isn't a good measure)

Create common range/guidelines based on local community needs for homelessness goals such as what do we mean by making homelessness \*brief\* or "rare."

measure access to care for persons without housing, and with chronic/acute medical or behavioral health challenge exiting institutional setting (jail, hospital, etc.).
