Section 5: Qualitative Assessment

1. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local homeless goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlists, etc.)

The City and County of San Francisco Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH) is the recipient of San Francisco's Large City HEAP award. HSH is using 12 percent (\$1,299,313) of our total Large City HEAP funds (\$10,564,313) to implement a pilot Rapid Rehousing program for 40 adults experiencing homelessness, ages 18 and over. HSH is investing in Rapid Rehousing for adults to innovate and use lessons and strategies from the pilot to guide possible expansions to the portfolio of Rapid Rehousing. Prior to the HEAP-funded Rapid Rehousing for adults, there were 25 slots of Rapid Rehousing for adults experiencing homelessness funded by HSH. This pilot program and expansion is directly connected to HSH's 5-Year Strategic Framework goal to: *reduce chronic homelessness among adults 50 percent by December 2022.* Since launching the Rapid Rehousing program for adults, the partners that HSH funded have secured significant private investments to expand the program so that it also serves people experiencing homelessness who are formerly incarcerated. HEAP funds used toward Rapid Rehousing have provided significant and pivotal seed funding that has help us secure new investments, in addition to creating much needed added capacity to house people experiencing homelessness.

2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)

The City and County of San Francisco Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH) is the recipient of San Francisco's Large City HEAP award. HSH is using 85 percent (\$9,000,000) of our total Large City HEAP funds (\$10,564,313) to implement an innovative public-private partnership called Rising Up for youth, age 18-24, who are experiencing homelessness. Through Rising Up, HSH and our partners will house 500 youth through Rapid Rehousing and prevent homelessness for 450 youth through Problem Solving—an unprecedented expansion to the capacity of housing and prevention resources for youth in San Francisco. The \$9,000,000 in Large City HEAP funds that are being used for Rising Up are exclusively for Rapid Rehousing. The During the 9/01/2018-09/30/2019 reporting period, HSH and our partners launched Rising Up. Rising Up and Rapid Rehousing are a key part of the Homeless Response System in San Francisco and are incorporated into the local youth homelessness goals within HSH's 5-Year Strategic Framework. Specifically, the 500 Rapid Rehousing placements will help us reach our goal to: *reduce homelessness among youth by 50 percent by 2023*. The HEAP investments that we are using for Rising Up have also catalyzed our fundraising efforts to raise the total \$35,000,000. Since receiving the HEAP funds, HSH and our partners have raised an additional \$8,000,000 in local San Francisco City general funds and private funds.

All of HSH's Rapid Rehousing programs, Howorks with the adult and youth Rapid Rehousing programs to establish grant agreements that clearly state that 100 percent destechnical assistance to Rapid Rehousing providers, including their front line staff with practicing Housing First. Housing First had has been fully adopted and implemented by our Department.
