As of September 30, 2019, Glenn County has executed sub-agreements with Colusa and Trinity Counties to obligate funds for the purpose of addressing the immediate emergency
needs of homeless individuals and individuals at risk of homelessness in Colusa, Glenn, and Trinity Counties. Our COC elected to use the majority of the HEAP funds for Capital
Improvement projects and will use the 5% required to address the unique needs of our homeless youth population. HEAP funding has enabled our COC to have continuous,
interagency conversations focused on brainstorming innovative project ideas and has fostered increased collaboration within the continuum.

2. Describe how HEAP funds have contributed to your Continuum of Care making progress towards local youth homelessness goals (e.g. additional services provided, capacity created, systems building, investments made, lower waitlist, etc.)

HEAP funds have provided our continuum with the opportunity to serve our homeless youth, even as other funding sources have become depleted. We have increased our communication with our McKinney Vento Program Coordinator in the county to alert her of this funding source and our ability to help youth in need. Plans have begun for expending youth set-aside funds and will be reported in the next HEAP Annual Report.
